- Election of three representatives for the EFCNI "Parent Advisory Board" The elected members should represent:
 - small country
 - big country
 - eastern country

When thinking about nominating a person for the election, please take into consideration that he/ she should be in a position to meet certain requirements:

The representative would need time to attend the annual board meeting in Munich and also some events in Brussels throughout the year (travel costs will be covered). He/ she would need 5 - 10 hours per month for conceptual work and should be available for regular email exchange/ feedback.

The elected members would need to represent the interests of all associations in a neutral way.

Points to be discussed in Freising prior to the election:

- Length of an election period (two years or more?)
- Should there be a possibility for re-election?
- How many times should a member be re-elected?
- etc.

Issues, we should also discuss in Freising:

- More focus on prevention of preterm birth
- Health insurances excluding preterm infants
- Support of new parents' associations (tutorial system)
